**JOB DESCRIPTION, GENERAL FOR THE ROLE:**

**Attributions/duties:**

- Responsibility for the overall health, safety and welfare of self and colleagues.
- To ensure all behaviours are in compliance with HSEQ requirements.
- Proactive participation in project safety briefings, HIRA's and tool box talks.
- To use and maintain all controls, standards and procedures for the protection of self, colleagues and the environment.
- Actively report all undesired events and safety observations using the Safety Observation system and Undesired Events Report system.
- Actively report non-conformances using the Non-Conformance Report (NCR) system.
- Actively report and manage any unsafe act, condition or procedure or environmental unsafe acts and conditions to the immediate supervisor so that action can be taken to manage or minimise any and all risk.
- Handle of stores to and from supply vessels and within the vessel as directed by Materials Controller.

**Responsibilities:**

- Progress the work scope as directed in accordance with the relevant Task Plans and Procedures.
- Responsible for all deck areas in use by project operations.
- Carry out rigging and lifting operations as required.
- Maintain all projects rigging in use.
- Ensure all certification is maintained and suitable for use by project.
- Ensure all project equipment on deck is sea-fastened and secured.
- Ensure all cranes are operated safely and within design limits.
- Control all project related crane operations
- Assist the Shift Supervisor as directed.
- Operate, inspect and maintain all permanent and temporary lifting equipment throughout the installation as directed by the line management
- Ensure all lifting equipment and rigging is certified.
- Update and fill out monthly Pre-Use Rigging check list.
- Assist in launch and recovery of the Trencher, PLET's and other project equipment.
- Responsibility for deck safety and personnel involved in deck operations.

- Delegate riggers to assist in deck operations including mooring of VSL.
- Assist operation of cargo and ballast systems as directed by Marine CRO; including setting up and monitoring crude oil washing, tank cleaning and associated cargo equipment.
- Carry out manual checks of tank levels and sampling as required.
- Assist maintaining all cargo handling equipment, pumps, valves etc. in the cargo pump room, tanks and on deck in line with planned maintenance. when required
- Carry out Helicopter Landing Officer roles and responsibilities.
- Serviceability of the Helideck and, where applicable, helifuel skid facilities at all times including stock control and ordering of helifuel.
- Ensure cleanliness and tidiness of cranes, deck store, HLO office and rigging loft is maintained.
- Maintain upkeep and appearance of the vessel superstructure, decks and Laydown areas including fabric maintenance as required.
- Keeping Heads of Department and Materials Co-ordinator informed of usage and re-order requirements of deck consumables.
- Ensuring timely completion of Planned Maintenance routines
- Assist with the erection, dismantling of scaffolding and the transportation of scaffolding equipment and materials to the worksite as directed by the designated installation Scaffolder.
